**Narita Kokusai High School** was founded under the name Narita Nishi High School in 1975, and there was only a general course. However, Narita is home to Narita International Airport, Japan's main gateway to foreign countries, so it was decided that the school should have an international focus. Additionally, Narita has a long history, with many interesting traditions centered around Narita-san Shinshoji Temple. Therefore, to foster students who can make active contributions to international society, an English course was added in 1987. Then, the school was renamed Narita Kokusai High School in 1992 (*kokusai* means *international* in Japanese). There is now a general course and an international course. Over the years, more than 12,000 graduates of 'Narikoku' have made outstanding achievements in various international fields.

## EDUCATIONAL GOALS

1. To raise international understanding while teaching respect for our national culture and traditions, to broaden students' horizons and educate students to make positive contributions to international society.
2. To prepare students to navigate through and thrive in an increasingly international and technologically advanced society.
3. To teach students to be healthy in mind and body, to be creative in solving problems, and to be motivated to learn independently and plan for their future.
